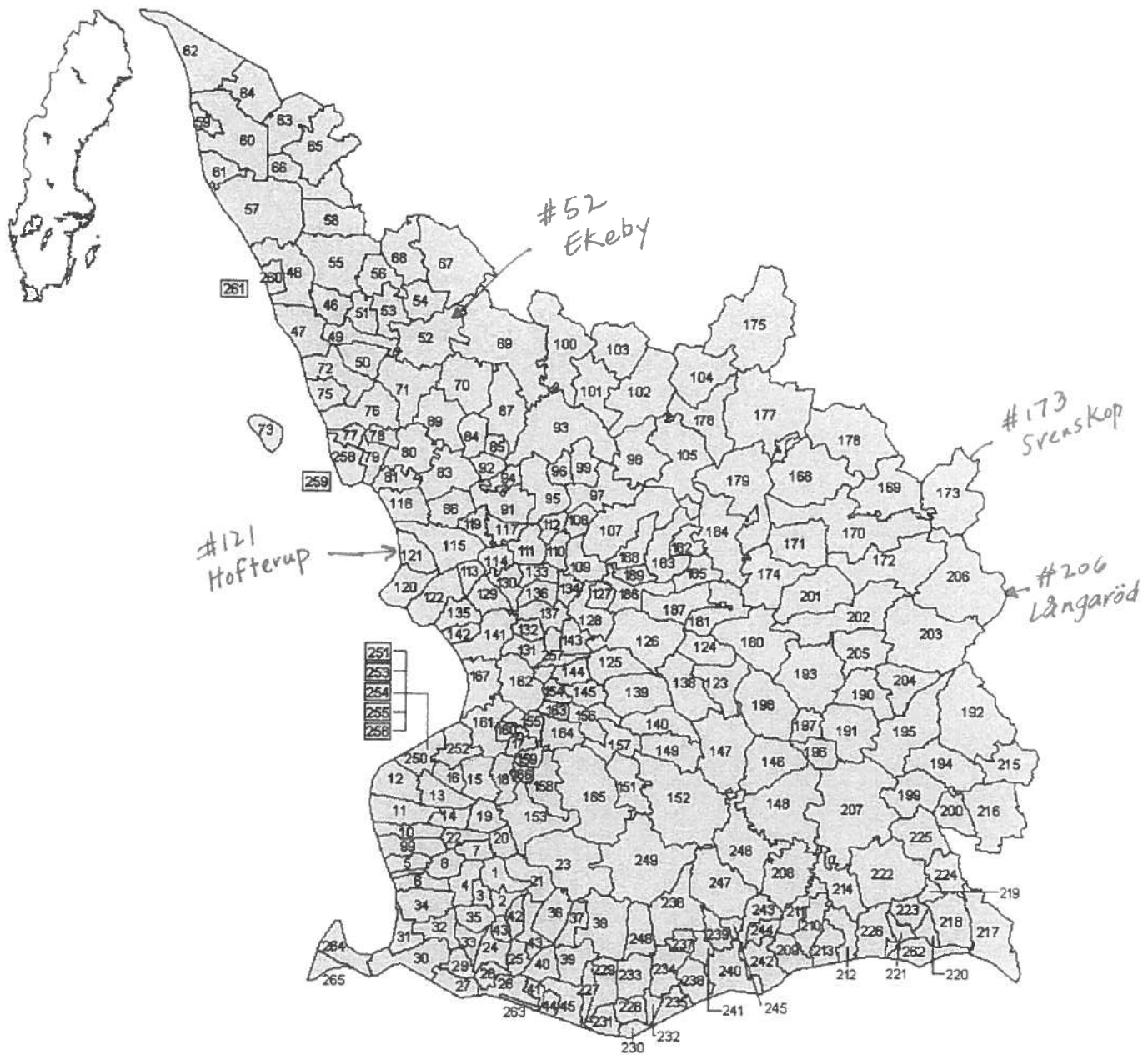

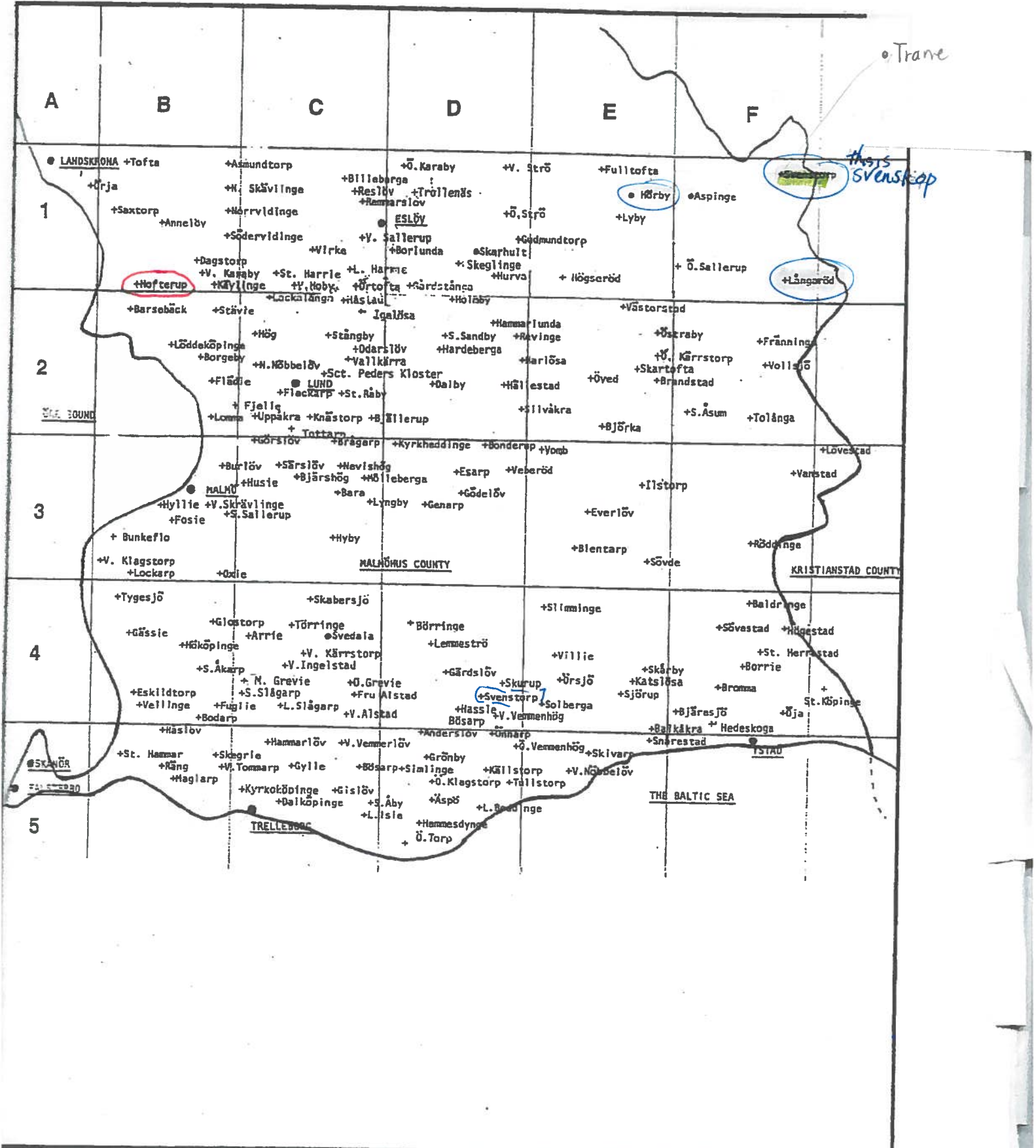

Carl August Johnson

August was the son of Svan (born 14 Mar 1838, died 22 Mar 1929?) and Ingar (B: Aug 1835, died 19 Oct 1914) Johnson.

C. Aug. Johnson was born in Jonstrop, Langrods socken, Malmohuslan, Sweden, the 12th of August, 1861. He answered the final summons Saturday morning, Nov. 5th, 1927, at the age of 66 years, 2 months, and 23 days.

Mr. Johnson came to America in the year 1882, coming to Nebraska in 1883. He married Hanna Hanson, the family making their home at Argo, later moving to Bertha. Twenty-six years ago, Mr. Johnson bought the place east of Oakland, where he lived together with his family until the time of his death. He was crippled with rheumatism for several years and the suffering and pain was hard to endure at times, but Mr. Johnson was not of a complaining nature. The last two years he was confined to a wheel chair. His daughter Edna cared for him, which she did in a loving and kind manner. The son Victor managed the farm after the father's infirmity became such that he could no longer do the work on the farm.

Although the suffering and pain had been great, the last days of his life were spent in ease, and his dying moments were as though he had entered a deep, calm and peaceful, natural sleep. He did not fear death and he was glad to go.

He leaves to mourn his departure his beloved wife and seven children: Victor, Walter, Edna, at home; Oscar, Mrs. Ruth Anderson, Mrs Henning Anderson of Oakland; Mrs. A.P. Peterson of Stockholm, S.D.; eight grandchildren; his elderly father at Atkinson; two brothers, Victor Johnson, Swen Johnson of Wausa; two sisters, Mrs. Peter Monson of Wausa, Mrs. Herman Anderson of Oakland, and many other relatives, together with a host of friends.

Mr. Johnson was an earnest Christian and to serve Him was his greatest delight. The loss is felt very keenly in home, church and

community, but to Mr. Johnson, death came as a relief from the sufferings of this world. Funeral services were held for Mr. Johnson from the home and later from the Free Church, Tuesday afternoon. The church was filled with relatives, neighbors and friends and there was an abundance of beautiful flowers. A mixed quartet composed of Adelaide Nelson, Eunice Nelson, John A. Nelson and Emil W. Nelson rendered two selections and Emil W. Nelson sang a solo, the Misses Adelaide Nelson and Eunice Nelson sang a duet, Miss Ethel Bengston presiding at the piano. Rev. O.E. Mars spoke impressively in English and Swedish. Burial was in the local cemetery.

Out of town relatives present at the last rites were: Mr. and Mrs. Swen J. Johnson and Mrs. Pete Monson of Wausa and Rev. and Mrs. A.P. Peterson of Stockholm, S.D.
